



FOREWORD

We've all heard the admonition, "Anything worth doing is worth doing well."

To be practical, with respect to broadcasting, this advisory might be reworded to read, "Anything worth saying is worth saying correctly."

The printed item you are holding is an attempt to clarify the pronunciation of Idaho place names.

Idaho is a state of extraordinary geographical distances, occupational varieties and "people interests." It is more than 650 miles by highway from Bonners Ferry to Montpelier. The logger who lives in Ahsahka has little in common with the cattle raiser in Banida. The woman whose husband is a contract sugar beet farmer near lona isn't much interested in the current silver quotations, but the wife of a miner in Kellogg is

Only a small percentage of Idahoans living north of the Salmon river have seen the Stanley Basin or the Arco Desert or the Bruneau River Canyon. By the same token, how many residents of Rigby or Weiser have visited the spectacular Moyie River Canyon or Dworshak Dam or Harpster Hill?

Inter-Idaho travel is on the increase in the 1970's, with more Idahoans visiting the far corners of their own state.

But the pronunciation problem remains.

Within their own state, Idaho residents are currently supporting eleven television stations and more than 40 radio stations, plus aiding the statistical causes of stations in Utah, Oregon and Washington.

It seems only proper that the news readers employed by these stations in Idaho and its neighboring states should possess the ability to correctly pronounce Idaho place names.

In 1947, I was a very young man employed as an announcer in a small southern Idaho radio station. One day our news wire copy contained a story from Kamiah. I'd never heard of the place and I pronounced it on the air the way it looks. A kind lady who was familiar with North Idaho places telephoned me after my newscast to tell me how to pronounce Kamiah. That may have been the start of my interest in correct place name pronunciation, with what you are holding as a much later effort.
